

Gletscher (glacier)

Like a block carved out of the glacier – crystal cut to a sculpture.

A heavy mouth-blown piece of crystal is cut until no curve remains. In contrast to the soft and round inner shape now a crude and squared outside is created giving shelter to the tender inside. The able bodied and sculptural character is enforced by the unpolished cuts. Sebastian Menschhorn was born in 1971 and finished his studies at Paolo Piva and Toshiyuki Kita. Since 1998 he is running his own studio for product and graphic design in Vienna.

The series consists of a ashtray for cigars, a small and a large vase, a caviar bowl, a little candle holder and a bowl.
